12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 BALTIMORE CITY MAY NOT ADOPT AN ORDINANCE THAT ELIMINATES OR 17 LIMITS THE COMMON LAW REQUIREMENT THAT A PERSON RETREAT FROM AN 18 ATTACK UNLESS THE PERSON:

19(1)DID NOT HAVE THE ABILITY TO RETREAT OR ESCAPE THE20DANGER; OR

21(2)COULD NOT RETREAT OR ESCAPE THE DANGER WHILE22MAINTAINING THE PERSON'S SAFETY.
