## Vehicle Laws - Hidden Compartments - Prohibition and Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from knowingly creating, building, or 4 installing a certain hidden compartment in a motor vehicle; prohibiting a person 5 from knowingly owning or operating a motor vehicle that contains a certain 6 hidden compartment; establishing that a certain intent to use a certain 7 enclosure in a certain manner may be established by the discovery of a person, 8 contraband, or certain evidence of a person or contraband in the enclosure; 9 establishing a certain penalty; authorizing the seizure of certain motor vehicles 10 involved in a violation of this Act; requiring the forfeiture of certain motor vehicles seized under this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to 11 12 hidden compartments in motor vehicles.
