Public Safety - Law Enforcement Officers - Video Cameras

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain law enforcement officer to wear a video camera 4 affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty; requiring that any interaction between a law enforcement officer and a member of the public be recorded; prohibiting a video camera from making an audio recording; requiring that a recording be preserved by a law enforcement agency for a certain period of time; requiring a law enforcement agency to develop certain policies and procedures; providing that this Act does not apply to a law enforcement officer who is on detective duty; defining certain terms; and generally relating to law enforcement officers and video cameras. 11

- "AUDIO RECORDING" MEANS A RECORDED CONVERSATION 23**(2)** 24 BETWEEN AN OFFICER AND ANOTHER PERSON.

- 3 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER 4 WHO IS ON DETECTIVE DUTY.
- 5 (C) (1) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL WEAR A VIDEO CAMERA AFFIXED TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S UNIFORM WHILE ON DUTY.
- 8 (2) (I) THE VIDEO CAMERA SHALL RECORD ANY INTERACTION 9 BETWEEN A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC.
- 10 (II) THE VIDEO CAMERA MAY NOT MAKE AN AUDIO 11 RECORDING.
- 12 (3) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PRESERVE A
 13 RECORDING MADE BY A VIDEO CAMERA UNDER THIS SECTION FOR AT LEAST 30
 14 CALENDAR DAYS.
- 15 (D) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL DEVELOP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO EXECUTE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
