18(B) IF AN INTERN IS NOT ENTITLED TO WAGES FOR THE TIME SPENT IN19THE INTERNSHIP, AN EMPLOYER SHALL REIMBURSE THE INTERN FOR20TRANSPORTATION COSTS INCURRED BY THE INTERN BECAUSE OF THE

21 INTERNSHIP.
